



The Good Traveler's Charter

You will be an official representative of your community; therefore, your behavior, gestures, attire, and language must reflect the education you receive at home and at school. Furthermore, in order for this stay to be a success and to ensure the continuation of this tradition at the College, you must read the following guidelines:

1. Respect, at all times, your school's rules of behavior regarding social skills and manners.
2. Be punctual in all activities.
3. Do not forget to report your presence to your designated chaperone.
4. Wear clean and appropriate attire for the activities.
5. Exercise discretion and restraint in public places.
6. During free or organized activities, you must remain in a group of at least four people at all times. If your group has fewer than four people, you must immediately join the chaperones for the rest of the day. Demonstrate team spirit: do not isolate yourself and do not allow anyone to become isolated.
7. You must never be in a room other than the one assigned to you.
8. It is important to respect the curfew set by the chaperones. No circulation outside the rooms will be tolerated.
9. You agree to strictly respect the directives of the people responsible for your group, particularly those concerning safety, schedule, and manners.
10. You also agree to respect the laws and regulations in force in the places visited.
11. In accordance with the College's rules of conduct, the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages, drugs, e-cigarettes, or any other vaping product is strictly prohibited during activities organized or sponsored by the College. Any breach of this rule constitutes a serious offense that may lead to expulsion from the group.



Attitude and Behavior on the Bus

- When boarding the bus, sit down in your seat **calmly** and **silently** so that the chaperones can take attendance.
- A hello and a thank you are always appreciated by the driver.
- During the trip, the bus will be very important for the group. It must therefore be **kept clean at all times**.
- Only use **the restrooms in case of extreme emergency**. Do not worry, we will make several stops along the way.

Attitude and Behavior in Public Places
