Reminder: documents required to visit the United States

Canadian citizens aged 18 and under travelling with a school or organized group, under adult supervision and with the consent of a parent or guardian, may present one of the following documents:

- Proof of citizenship (original birth certificate or paper copy, or Canadian citizenship card)
- A valid passport
